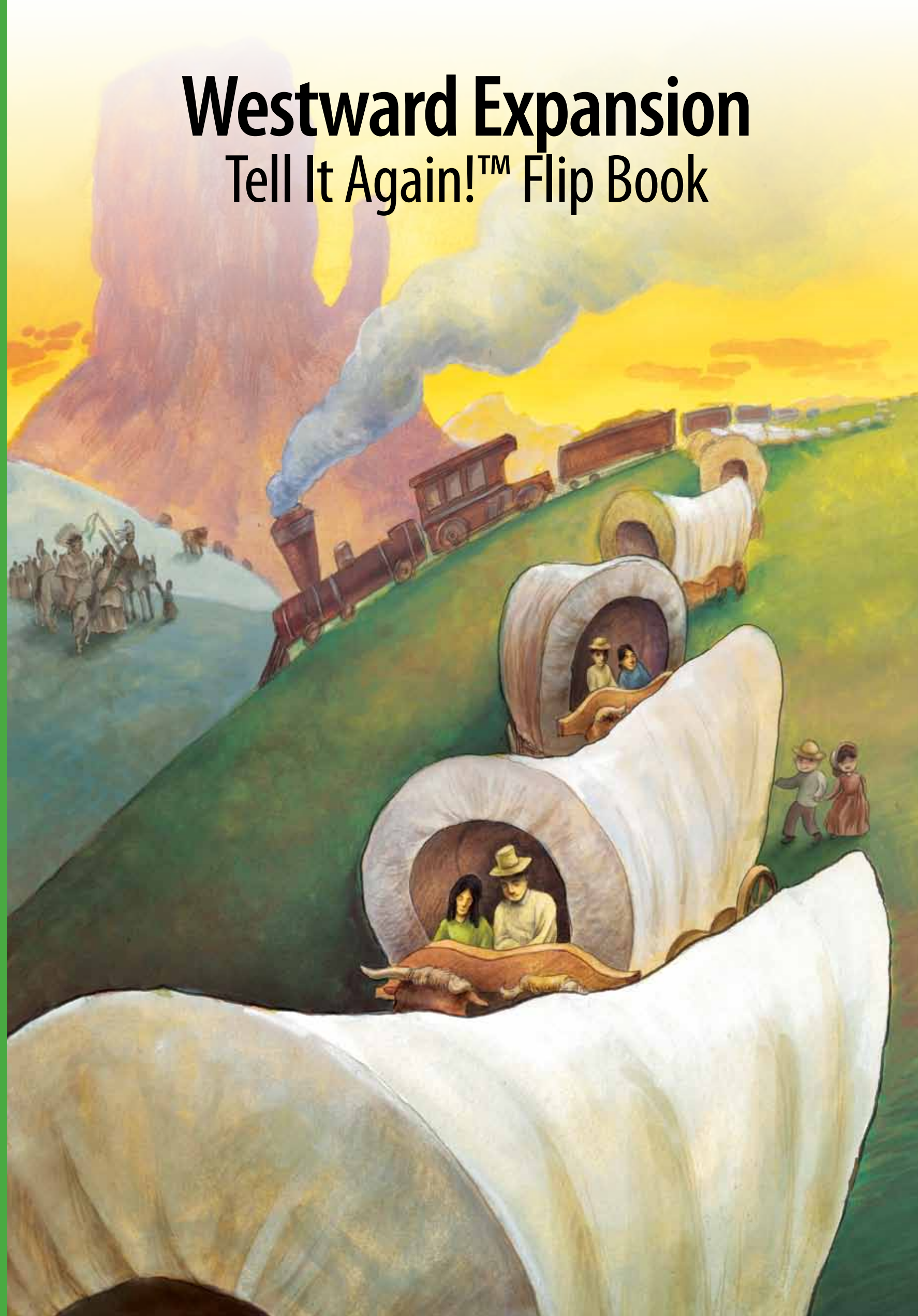

Tell It Again! Flip Book Introduction

This *Tell It Again! Flip Book* contains images that accompany the *Tell It Again! Read-Aloud Anthology for Westward Expansion*. The images are in sequential order. Each image is identified by its lesson number, read-aloud letter (A or B), and the number of the image within the particular read-aloud. For example, the first image in Read-Aloud 1A is numbered 1A-1. Once you have worked your way through the book to the last page, you will flip the entire book over to view the second half of the images.

Depending on your classroom configuration, you may need to have students sit closer to the Flip Book in order to see the images clearly.

THE PONY EXPRESS TRAIL
1860 - 1861

The first Pony Express trip between St. Joseph and Sacramento was 1,942 miles. The first trip took 10 days. The Pony Express operated from April 1, 1860, to October 26, 1861. The trail was 3,000 feet high and covered 8,000 miles West.

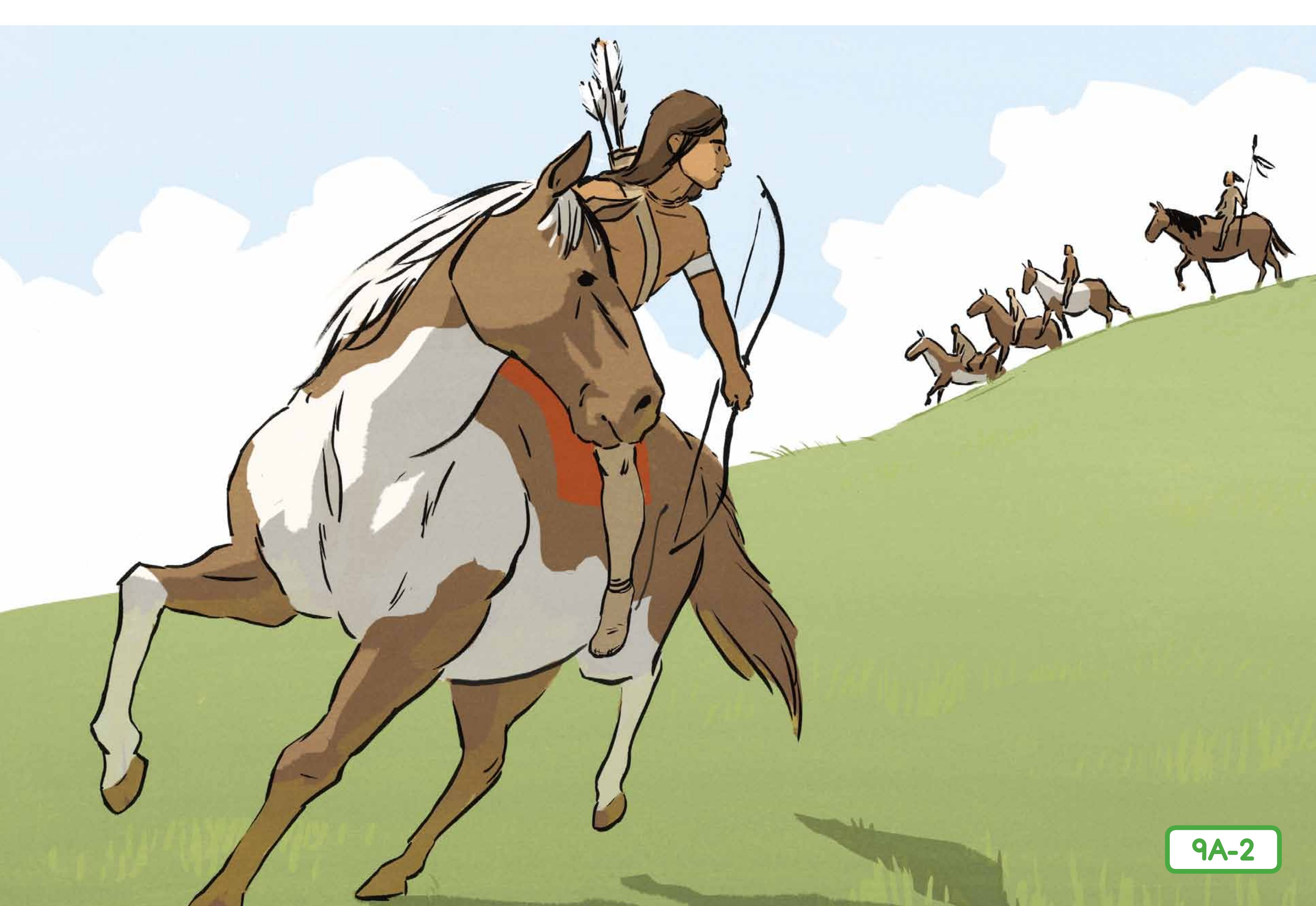

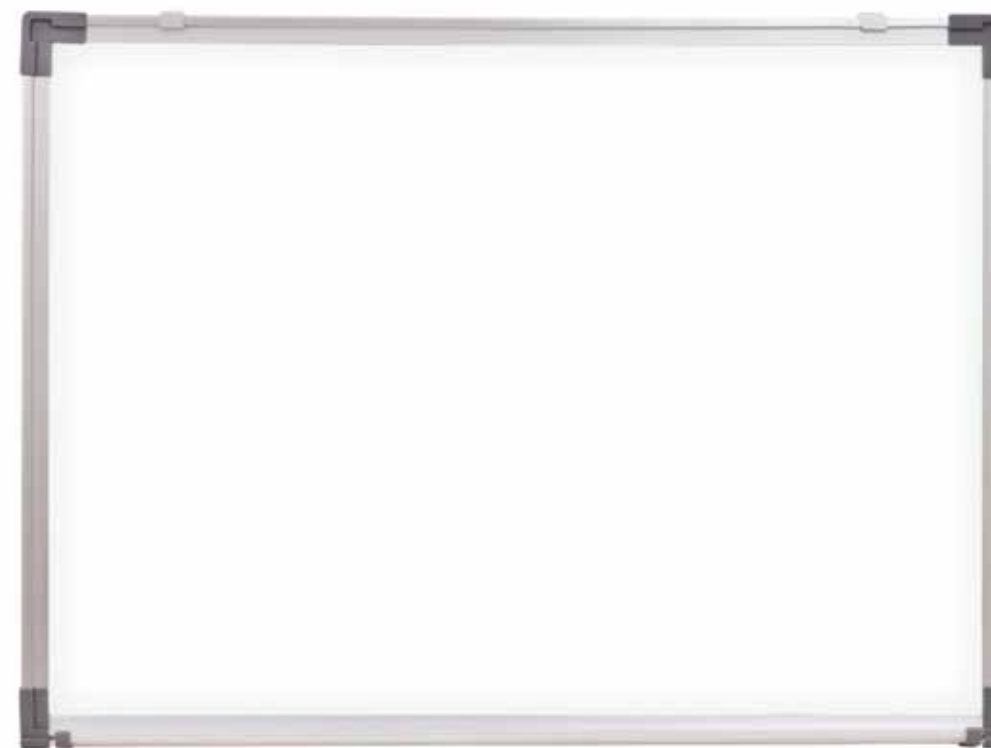
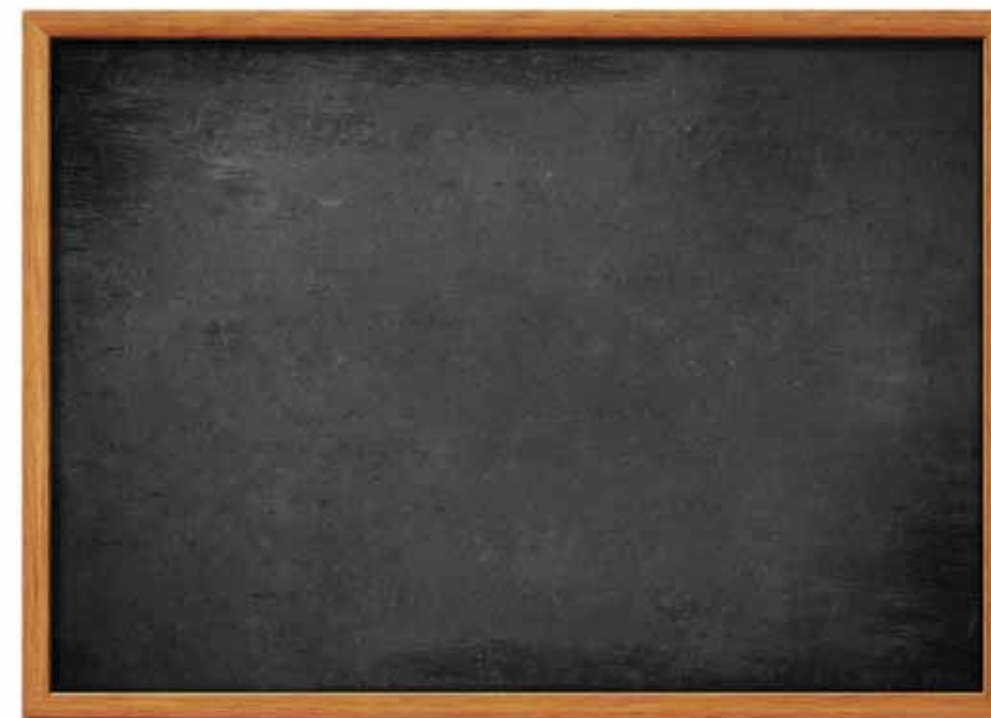
Back (Poster 1M)

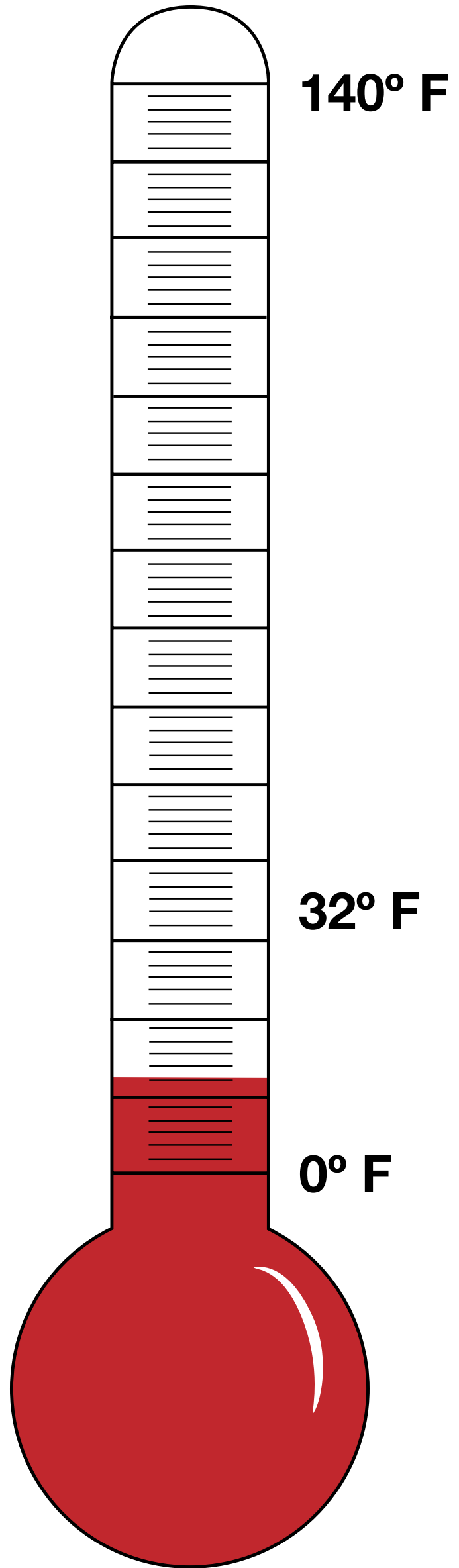




Board (Poster 2M)

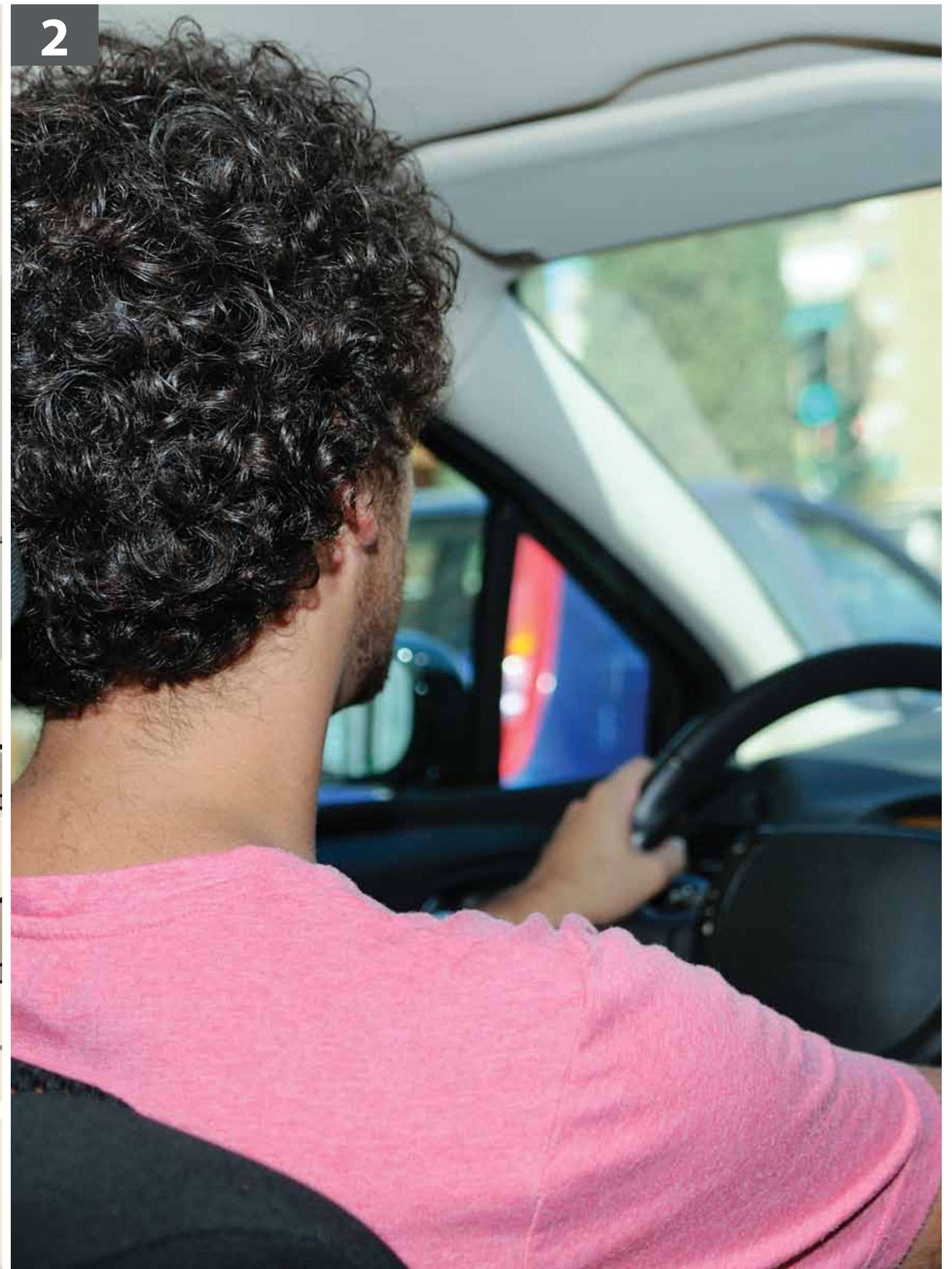
Degree (Poster 3M)
