## OUR MUNICIPALITY.

A record meeting of the Municipal Board was that which was held on the 23rd. The Tax Darogah had to go, and with him his Chief the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman who volunteered to resign and they did resign. There was a clearance but the augean stable remains all the same. The quest on now is where is the Hercules. A clique of an unwholy character was formed and with a set purpose to retain the services of the Tax Darogah against his own will, against the order of the Divisional Commissioner and against the opinion of some of the members of the Board. The attempt failed. The wrangling at the meeting was a sight to be seen and a spectacle dramatic enough though by no means edifying. The Tax Darogah had to clear out any how. The gordian knot was thus solved. The Tax Darogah poor old man was the bone of contention and is now at rest. The Chairman is gone leaving legacies which cannot be taken to forebode any good. In our opinion what was bad is now worse. There much chuckling and snapping of us. We wrote and said that the members of the Municipal Board had better be on their look out. This crisis at which the Municipality stood is only intensified. In the Medical pharmacopoeia in certain diseases crisis is a cure. But not so in a constitutional disease. The executive authorities are not satisfied, as the rumour goes with the doings of the Municipality. The rate-payers are not. As a matter of fact no one is satisfied with any one. There was a reciprocity in the traction of feelings between the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman and therefore they went of their own accord. The Chairman had merits of his own but by irony of fate he lost the opportunity, the golden opportunity to win a good name for the Municipality and withal for himself. Now is the time for the members of the Municipal Board to adjust their own nose and arrange matters that there would be no chance for another fiasco. Let us expect for the fair name of the Municipality that ambitious noodles are carefully weighed and wooed out. It is a well known fact that the outgoing Chairman was the nominee of the nominated members of the Board who in a body voted for him and those who are in the know know it well how it was engineered and acted upon at the eleventh hour. The result is the present miserable fiasco witnessed by the people and the public and for which the majority of the elected representatives of the ratepayers are not to blame. Let us hope that the nominated Commissioners will have their eyes opened and will not interfere again. The rule prohibiting the nominated Commissioners to vote at the election of members to the Legislative Council is a wholesome one and ought to be introduced in the local elections also if the Govt. is sincerely trying to train the people in the principle of self Government.

## THE PATNA UNIVERSITY BILL.

The Patna University Bill has at last emerged out of the avil of the Select Committee. We must own that the Bill as revised by the Select Committee contains some very material changes which are calculated to meet the almost unanimous opposition which the original Bill aroused. Of the material changes, we may mention the incorporation of the Diamond Jubilee College as an external College, the modification of the powers of the Chancellor so as to give him the right of inspecting the University and its proceedings, of visiting and inspecting the Colleges and annulling any proceedings not in conformity with the Act and the regulations, the reduction of the term of the Vice-chancellor's

appointment from 5 to 3 years, the raising of the number of ordinary fellows of the Senate from a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 60 to a minimum of 60 and a maximum of 75, the increase in the number of elected fellows on the Senate from 12 to 50, the provision relating to the adequate representation of persons permanently resident in the Orissa Division, the revision of the powers of the Senate so as to allow it larger scope, the distribution of the powers of the Senate and the Syndicate, the constitution of the Syndicate so as to include at least one person permanently resident in Orissa, and the provision relating to the framing of the regulations indicating those which *must* be made and those which *may* be made. The original Bill provided that no educational institution should be admitted as an external College unless the College buildings would be situate in one of the four specified towns of the province. The revised Bill modifies the provision by making it applicable only to Colleges teaching up to the Degree Standard and even then (the Governor General has power to dispense with the condition in any particular case. Though the provision still appears hard, we are glad to find at least a proviso conferring powers on the Governor General to make exception to the General rule. We are thankful to our Hon'ble Raja Saheb of Kanika for his strenuously fighting out the cause of Orissa and we suppose it is due to him alone that we find the Principal of the Ravenshaw College as one of the ex officio fellows of the Syndicate. We also find that provision is made to so frame the constitution of the Syndicate as to include at least one permanent resident of Orissa in it. In the provision relating to the constitution of the Senate we find that it is mandatory that Orissa should be adequately represented therein. All this is due to our Raja Saheb, and all Orissa should be sincerely grateful to him for the part he has played in the cause of Orissa. At the same time we must remember that we have one College and one College only and there is very little likelihood of the multiplication of any more College in the near future. The demands for higher education is every day increasing. Government no doubt grants a number of scholarships for the encouragement of the study of law and medicine. There are post-graduate scholarships too. But these fall far short of Orissa's demands. The Ravenshaw College has no provision to teach beyond the B. A. and B. Sc. degrees. The Engineering School has been postponed sine die. The Survey School is a farce. For the study of law one has to cross the Ganges or offer *Pindar* (oblation) at Gaya. But then the inconvenience and expense are to be taken into account as the stumbling blocks in the way. The pressing necessity of providing for the study of law and for post-graduate teaching in the Ravenshaw College is a fact patent enough and ought not to be ignored. So far we have no cause to be jubilant. One member in the Syndicate or the representation of Orissa in the Senate are useful in their own way but in comparison with the wants of Orissa we must confess they are nothing. The members in the Senate or the Syndicate cannot work out the salvation of Orissa unless and until there is adequate provision for giving sound education to our youths. We hope before the New University is worked out arrangement should be made at Cuttack for teaching M.A. and B.L. Orissa won't be satisfied until and unless it gets them. She won't be satisfied till arrangements are made for imparting technical education to her sons. Hopes are held out to us of a future Oriya University. We have more than once in these columns pointed out that until and unless we get trained men to man the future university, the hope will be realised more in dreams than in realities.

## THE MEDICAL HOSTEL AT CALCUTTA.

### THE KATJORI EMBANKMENT.

We are exceedingly glad to know that our worthy and esteemed Commissioner is going to confer a boon to the people of Cuttack by inaugurating certain improvements along the bank of the Katjori commencing from the collector's Kutchery up to the Puri hat. The now narrow, rugged and rough footpath, if a footpath it can be called, is to be widened in the apex of a miniature strand with a sufficient number of light posts. Seats and convenient intervals will also be provided, with a few sheds at suitable points. The Katjori river bank is a favourite and fascinating resort of peregrination of all classes of people of this town. In the flood season, it is especially so. In the evening most of the gentries and not unoften purdah ladies go about a stroll and since the installation of the little Kali Mandir, the Ganesh Ghat has been a place of attraction to the people of the town of both sexes and latterly the Puri return Sadhus are visiting it to the great joy of the people both rich and poor of the town. When the Temple was constructed it created a certain amount of sensation, or we would rather say, a certain amount of nervousness in the touchy minds of the public work authorities, but the intrepid Mataji went on undaunted and when the then District Officer Mr. Berthoud was approached with facts which had been misrepresented to him by an Apkewasie Indian Gazetted Officer, the situation was saved and Mr. Berthoud's name stands enshrined with the temple of Ma Kali. The Katjori bank is therefore a happy resort and when its improvement is the idea of our Commissioner it is, needless to say, a "fait-accompli" almost. The Katjori embankment is an ancient one, built more than a thousand years ago and when the contemplated improvement is complete, the Hon'ble Mr. LeMesurier's name will go down to posterity along with the prestige of the Marahatte stone-built embankment. So far so good. But what about the odorous "Indian bouquet" the "Purisha" delivered day and night by means which we Indians only know wherever there are banks of rivers, streams or streamlets, tanks, ponds or wells. Indian sense of sanitation, without vanity, has no bounds. The less said about this the better. All that we wish and implore is that the great and costly improvement our Commissioner is going to give us would be free once for all from the miasma of Putigandha (filthy smell.)

### THE KANIKA RAJ HIGH ENGLISH SCHOOL.

A few weeks ago we announced in our Vernacular columns the recognition and affiliation by the Calcutta University of the High English School at Raj Kanika. An addition of another High School is an acquisition to us. As to the efficiency of the institution we have not the least doubt. The enlightened Raja Shahab of whom we know is going to spare no pains for the improvement of the High School. It is already well equipped in building and with a splendid Hostel to boot. The teaching staff is well selected and the Raja Shahab has already offered a scholarship of Rs. 10 per mensem tenable for two years at the Ravenshaw College to the candidate that stands first among the successful matriculates from the School in 1919. We wish all success to the Raj Kanika H. E. School and need we say how we wish it to show at least a magnanimous rivalry in the cause of the great ad of education.

It is true the Oriya students of the Medical College at Calcutta have been provided with a Hostel, but the remedy has proved worse than the disease. From one of our correspondents we are informed that the house selected for the Hostel is ill-suited in every way. It is situated in a bad quarter of the town with a preponderating Mahomedan population in the vicinity. The rooms are 9-3" by 9-7" with a height of 10-5". The capacity is 898 cubic feet. The arrangement is that each room is to be occupied by two students. Our correspondent says that the rooms are sufficiently ventilated but the Mahomedan house holders have already shown signs of intimidation if the windows are kept open. The privy is close to the kitchen. The effect of this proximity can better be imagined than described. Now that a building has been provided for, the Oriya students have been made to go and live there and from what we have said the comfort and convenience of the poor students can easily be imagined. We do not know who is responsible for this sort of arrangement. Could not a better house be found elsewhere in the City of Calcutta? They were perhaps more comfortable when they were living in their own messes, but this compulsory arrangement is in no way desirable.

### PURI ADOPTION.

In re the Puri adoption matter we have been reading its literature with a sort of disgusting curiosity. We are informed that means are being adopted by a certain good-two-pice-earning party to make the Puri Gajapati adopt one who has already gone through his Upanayana ceremony. What could be more irreligious and ridiculous. We wait to see further development.

We have much pleasure in publishing the following para received from the Lady Principal of the Ravenshaw Girls' School although we had already noticed in the vernacular columns of the last issue of the Dipika.

"Miss Lydia Sahu, who passed the I. A. Examination from the College Classes of the Ravenshaw Girls' High School, Cuttack, has been awarded a Government Senior Scholarship of Rs. 25 tenable at the Diocesan College, Calcutta, where she is already studying for the B. A.

Her subjects were Sanskrit, Oriya, English, History and Logic."

### THE RIVER GHAT TYRANNY.

In our last issue we published a letter from Pandit Mrityunjoy Rath and made some comments in our Vernacular columns regarding the oppression of the Ghatwallas by which we mean the Ijedar and his myrmidons the Majhis. Numerous complaints have reached us. This is the flood season and the Majhis are exercising a sort of regular tyranny by extorting an extra two pice from the poor and helpless passengers who are at their mercy. Most of the ghats belong to the District Board or the Municipality and we dare say if this is brought to the notice of the Chairman of both the Boards there will be a ready check.

Our Puri correspondent informs us that a proposal has again been set on foot to remove the popular Lion's Gate Coronation Dispensary much against the will of the rate-payers. The Dispensary has not only done much to meet a long felt want, but has proved a real boon to the suffering humanity and especially to the poorer class of rate-payers and the pilgrims who can not afford the costly Allopathic private treatment. The institution commemorates the death of our late lamented Emperor King Edward VII. We understand a mass meeting of the rate-payers was held on the 5th inst. to protest against this unwise measure. A similar proposal was made in 1914 while His Honour the Lieutenant Governor was at Puri and His Honour very kindly investigated into the matter with the result that a grave calamity was averted. We only hope that Mr. Dixon the popular Magistrate of Puri and our Commissioner the Hon'ble Mr. LeMesurier will not allow the closure of such a useful and exceedingly popular institution started for the relief of the suffering humanity.

Under the auspices of the Utkal Young Men's Association a meeting was held last Thursday at 5 p. m. at the Ravenshaw College to give a hearty send off to Babu Nilmani Senapati B. Sc. on the eve of his departure to England to study for the I. C. S. Examination. The principal of the College Mr. Lambert being unavoidably absent Mr. Khosla presided at the Meeting. In spite of the inclemency of the weather there was a large attendance of students, Professors and gentlemen. We wish all success to Babu Nilmani Senapati whose brilliant academic career has aroused high hopes in the hearts of his country men.

"We have become the paramount power in India by a series of conquests in which we have used Indian soldiers and had Indian allies. We have remained the paramount power in India because the Indian peoples needed our protection against foreign foes and against internal disorder. We must now look at our paramount position in the light of our own war-ideal. The British rule in India must aim at giving India opportunities of self-development according to the natural bent of its peoples. With this in view the first object of its rulers must be to train Indians in self-government. If we turn away from any such application of our principles to this country, it is but hypocrisy to come before God with the plea that our cause is the cause of liberty."

*The Lord Bishop of Calcutta in his sermon at St. Paul's Cathedral on the War anniversary Day.*

Referring to the circular prohibiting students from attending political meetings Lord Willingdon Governor of Bombay said:—"Let me first assure you that this circular had been issued before without adverse comment and was only issued again because it had come to our knowledge that students were going to political meetings and ignoring the orders contained in the circular, and let me perfectly frankly tell you the reason. Special reference was made to meetings on Home Rule because some of the speeches made on that subject have been of a decidedly intemperate character and it was considered, and I think rightly considered, most undesirable that young men should get their heads filled with that sort of oratory. This sort of rule is, believe me, not peculiar to India. For I can well remember during my life as a student at Cambridge that a general election took place, and all political meetings were put absolutely out of bounds for all students by the authorities, and indeed, I think, it is held in every civilized country that a young man is sent to college by his parents to complete his education and to develop his physical powers, so as to prepare him for the strain of the battle of life, and not in order that he may divert his mind from his studies in the wear and tear of the excitement of political meetings. When I was at Cambridge we had our debating societies, and so, I believe, have you, and I can imagine nothing more useful to you in your future careers than calm and reasoned discussions of great questions which are of interest to your country and Empire. I go further and say, with the consent of your Principal that it would be an excellent thing to invite leading gentlemen and statesmen to come and take part in those discussions. But I would urge on you all—and I speak with considerable experience of political life—that you will have quite time enough after you leave your college to engage, if you wish to, in the arena of politics, and that it is for your ultimate advantage that this order has been in existence for several years past. Believe me, I realize fully and can still warmly sympathize with the ideals, aspirations and enthusiasm of youth and I should be the last person to unnecessarily check them, and, if I might give you a word of advice in conclusion, it would be to urge you never to be carried away by catch words and catch phrases, but, while keeping your eyes always fixed on the stars of your ideals and ambitions, to keep your feet firmly fixed on the ground of reason and sound judgment. If you do this you will all find your aid in your various professions to the advance of your country to that full and equal partnership with the other Dominions within the great Empire which we are all proud to belong."

"We read in the Mail papers that instructions are to be sent out by the Gloucestershire County Council to demonstrate the value of the wild foods of England including (apparently) snails, frogs, hedgehogs, nettles, dulse and samphire. In France, of course, the practice of eating snails is universal, the daily consumption in Paris alone reaching sometimes as much as 50 tons. Snail farming is a profitable pursuit. But in England the eating of snails and frogs is practically unknown, and we are sorry to find that the custom may be revived. Some three hundred years ago, we know, snails were eaten in Merrie England, for the poet Edmund Spenser gives a recipe in verse of their preparation."
